A mandatory uniform policy has been instituted as part of the Public School Choice 3.0 Application for Harry Bridges Span School. Our basic standard for students is to dress as if they were coming to work. School is a place of business and education is the student's job. Research has found that the use of school uniforms enhances school safety, improves the learning environment, reduces ethnic and racial tensions, bridges socioeconomic differences between children, promotes good behavior, improves children's self-respect and self-esteem, and produces cost savings for families. Failure to follow the mandatory uniform policy will result in a referral to the office to change to the appropriate clothing. The school will assist in providing uniforms for students who have financial difficulties. There will be no uniform waivers issued to students unless an "opt-out" card is on file in the main office.

To ensure health and safety standards there will be 1) no attire advertising alcoholic or tobacco products or any controlled substance, 2) no attire that expresses or suggests profanity, acts of sex, racial slurs or concepts found to be in poor taste or culturally offensive or aggressive, 3) no attire that is sexually suggestive or extremely tight/brief, and 4) no clothing or accessories that are or can be interpreted as gang or crew related.
